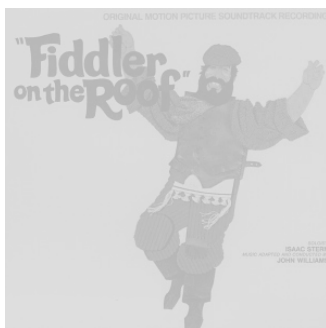

DIVISION I – HORTICULTURE “TO LIFE, TO LIFE, LECHAIM”

Eligible for Award of Horticultural Excellence
All classes are open to FGCNYS members.
Sections E and F are open to the public.

SECTION A – “TEVYE – THE MILKMAN” FLOWERING BRANCHES

Eligible for Arboreal Award
Single branch, spray or truss 24” or less from tip to cut end.

- CLASS
1. Rhododendron
 2. Philadelphus virginialis (Mock Orange)
 3. Any other flowering branch

SECTION B – “MOTEL – THE TAILOR” BROAD LEAF EVERGREENS

Eligible for Award of Merit
Single branch, 24” or less from tip to cut end.

- CLASS
4. Aucuba
 - 4a. Variegated Aucuba
 5. Euonymous
 - 5a. Variegated Euonymous
 6. Ilex (Holly)
 - 6a. Variegated Ilex (Holly)
 7. Any other Broad Leaf Evergreen

SECTION C – “PERCHIK - THE STUDENT” CONIFERS

Eligible for Arboreal Award and Jeanette DeLillo Award.
Single branch, spray or truss to include several nodes.
24” or less from tip to cut end.

- CLASS
8. Chamaecyparis
 9. Juniperus (Juniper)
 10. Picea (Spruce)
 11. Pinus (Pine)
 12. Taxus (Yew)
 13. Thuja (Arborvitae)
 14. Any Dwarf Conifer

SECTION D – “GOLDE - TEVYE’S WIFE” PERENNIALS

Eligible for Award of Merit
No more than 18” from tip to cut end.

- CLASS
16. Hosta
 17. Dianthus (Carnations & Pinks)
 18. Any other Perennial
 19. Any Biennial

SECTION E – “TZEITEL - THE ELDEST DAUGHTER” ROSES

Eligible for Award of Merit
Single stem 18” or less from tip to cut end.

- CLASS
20. Rosa (Floribunda)
 21. Rosa (Hybrid Tea)
 22. Rosa (Any other Rose)

SECTION F – “HODEL - THE MIDDLE DAUGHTER” CONTAINER GROWN PLANTS

FLOWERING container 10” or less in diameter.
Eligible for Award of Merit and Growers Choice Award

- CLASS
23. Gesneriad (including Saintpaulia)
 24. Orchid
 25. Any other Flowering Plant

SECTION G – “CHAVA - THE YOUNGEST DAUGHTER” CONTAINER GROWN PLANTS

FOLIAGE container 10” or less in diameter.
Eligible for Award of Merit and Growers Choice Award.

- CLASS
26. Spathiphyllum (Peace Lily)
 27. Succulent (including Cacti)
 28. Herb
 29. Any other Foliage Plant

SECTION H – “NOW I HAVE EVERYTHING” COLLECTIONS

Eligible for Collector’s Showcase Max. space per collection 24”x24”

- CLASS
30. Collection of 5 or more Container Plants
 31. Collection of 5 or more Cut Broad Leaf Evergreens (24” or less from tip to cut end.)
 32. Collection of 5 or more Cut Conifers (24” or less from tip to cut end.)

**DIVISION II – DESIGN
“TRADITION”**

Eligible for Design Excellence Award.

All plant materials must be listed on 3"x5" index card provided by the committee.

SECTION A – “DO YOU LOVE ME?”

Eligible for Designer’s Choice Award and Concetta DeLillo Award

Exhibitor has complete freedom to choose plant materials and other components within NGC policies.

Class 1 – “FAR FROM THE HOME I LOVE”

A **creative** design staged on a black round pedestal 18” in diameter and 36” high. Pedestal supplied by committee. (4 entries)

Class 2 – “WEDDING DANCE”

A **sculptural** design staged on a white pedestal 18” square and 36” high. Pedestal supplied by committee. (4 entries)

Class 3 – “SUNRISE SUNSET”

A **stretch** design staged against a backboard 24” high x 36” wide x 24” deep. Backboard to be supplied by committee. (4 entries)

SECTION B – “THE DREAM”

Eligible for Table Artistry Award and Sue Fink Award.
Exhibitor has choice of fresh, dried, or dried treated plant material.

Class 4 – “WHEN MESSIAH COMES”

An exhibition table, type 2, placed against a foam backboard 36” high x 24” wide x 24” deep. Backboard to be supplied by committee. (4 entries)

Class 5 – “MATCHMAKER”

A functional table for two staged on a bridge table. Table supplied by committee. (4 entries)

Class 6 – “IF I WERE A RICH MAN”

A buffet table for six staged on a rectangular table 30” x 72”. Table provided by committee. (4 entries)

SECTION C – “CHAVELAH – LITTLE BIRD”

Eligible for Petite Award.

Class 7 – “LAZAR WOLF – THE BUTCHER”

A small design using only fresh plant material to be staged in a black display unit 21” x 12”. Space allotted is 8 ½” x 5 ½”. (4 entries)

Class 8 – “MENDEL –THE RABBI’S SON”

A small design using a combination of fresh and dried plant material staged in a black display unit 21” x 12”. Space allotted is 8 ½” x 5 ½”. (4 entries)

Class 9 – “AVRAHM – THE BOOKSELLER”

A petite design using only dried plant material. Design may not exceed 5” in height, width, or depth. Staged in a display unit 21” x 12”. (4 entries)
