Eligible for **Arboreal Award**. Single branch, spray or truss 24” or less from tip to cut end.

Container 10” or less in diameter.

Exhibitor has complete freedom to choose plant materials and other components within NGC policies.

CLASS 1 – “CAROUSEL FOR CHILDREN”

A creative design staged **in a hoop** on a black pedestal 18” in diameter 36” high. Underlay permitted. Pedestal & hoop supplied by committee. (4 entries).

CLASS 2 – “SANDY GROUND”

A sculptural design staged on a white pedestal 18” in diameter 36” high. Underlay permitted. Pedestal supplied by committee. (4 entries)

CLASS 3 – “SNUG HARBOR CULTURAL CENTER”

A creative design staged against a backboard 30” high x 24” wide x 24” deep. Back drop and underlay permitted. Backboard to be supplied by committee. (4 entries)

SECTION B – “FOOD FOR THOUGHT”

Eligible for **Table Artistry Award & Sue Fink Award.**

Exhibitor has choice of fresh, dried, or dried treated plant material.

CLASS 4 – “PICNIC AT CLEAR COMFORT”
