SECTION A – "Here We Go Round the Mulberry Bush"

CUT BRANCHES/FLOWERING BRANCHES

Eligible for **Arboreal Award**

Single branch, spray or truss 30" or less from tip to cut end.

1. *Rhododendron*
 2. *Spirea* (Bridalwreath)
 3. Any other flowering branch

SECTION B – "The House that Jack Built"

CUT BRANCHES/BROAD LEAF

EVERGREENS

Eligible for **Award of Merit**

Single branch, 30" or less from tip to cut end.

4. *Aucuba*
 5. *Euonymous*
 6. *Ilex* (Holly)
 7. Any other Broad Leaf Evergreen

SECTION C – "Up in the Green Orchard"

CUT BRANCHES/CONIFERS

Eligible for **Arboreal Award**

Single branch, spray or truss to include several nodes. 24" or less from tip to cut end.

 9. *Juniperus* (Juniper)
 10. *Picea* (Spruce)
 11. *Pinus* (Pine)
 12. *Taxus* (Yew)
 13. *Thuja* (Arborvitae)
 14. Any Dwarf Conifer

SECTION D - "Mary, Mary"

PERENNIALS

Eligible for **Award of Merit**

No more than 18" from tip to cut end.

- Class
16. *Aquilegia* (Columbine)
 17. *Dianthus* (Carnations & Pinks)
 18. Any other Perennial

SECTION E – "I'm a Little Dutch Girl"

Bulbs eligible for **Award of Merit**. Single stem.

- Class
19. Narcissus (Daffodils & Narcissus)

 21. Hyacinth

SECTION F – "One for the Money"

CONTAINER GROWN PLANTS FLOWERING
container 10" or less in diameter.

Eligible for **Award of Merit & Growers Choice Award**

DIVISION II - DESIGN

“NURSERY RHYMES”

All plant materials must be listed on a 3” x 5” index card.

SECTION A – “FIDDLE DEE DEE”

Eligible for **Designer’s Choice Award** Exhibitor has complete freedom to choose plant materials and other components within NGC policies.

Class 1

“DANCING AROUND THE MAYPOLE”

A creative design staged on a black pedestal 18” in diameter 36” high. Underlay permitted. Pedestal supplied by Committee. (4 entries)

Class 2

“ THE COW JUMPED OVER THE MOON”

A creative design staged on a backboard in which two parallel lines are used to define the volume of a vacant space. Table supplied by Committee. (4 entries)

Class 3

“JACK AND THE BEANSTALK”

A large creative design staged on the floor not to exceed 5ft. (4 entries)

SECTION B - "PAT-A-CAKE"

Eligible for **Table Artistry Award**. Designer has choice of fresh and/or dried plant material, accessories and other components.

Class 4 “ANTS GO MARCHING”

A creative design to be staged in a picnic basket.

Baskets provided by Committee. (4 entries)

Class 5

“POLLY PUT THE KETTLE ON”

A functional table for two staged on a bridge table.

Tables provided by Committee. (4 entries)

Class 6

“TEA WITH THE QUEEN”

A buffet table for six staged on a rectangular table 30” x 72”. Tables provided by Committee.

(4 entries)

SECTION C – “TWINKLE TWINKLE LITTLE STAR”

Eligible for **Petite Award**. Exhibitor has complete freedom to choose plant materials and other components within NGC policies.

Class 7 “I’M A LITTLE TEAPOT”

A small design using only fresh plant material. Design not to exceed 8” in height, width & depth. Staged in a Lucite niche supplied by Committee. (4 entries)

Class 8 "INCY WINCY SPIDER"

A small design using only dried plant material. Design not to exceed 8” in height, width & depth. Staged in a Lucite niche supplied by Committee. (4 entries)

Class 9 “THUMBELINA”

A petite design using a combination of fresh and dried flowers. Design may not exceed 5” in height, width, & depth. Staged in a Lucite niche provided by Committee. (4 entries)
