SECTION A – “DESIGNERS IN TIME” Fresh and/or dried plant material and other components permitted. Eligible for **DESIGNER’S CHOICE AWARD**. Exhibitor has complete freedom to choose plant materials and other components within National Garden Club policies.

Class 1. “COCO CHANEL”

CREATIVE DESIGN to be staged on a black pedestal 18” in diameter – 36” high. Design may extend above & below pedestal. Committee to supply pedestal. (4 entries).

Class 2. ”BOB MACKIE”

ABSTRACT DESIGN to be staged on a white pedestal 18” in diameter 36” high. Design may extend above and below pedestal.
Committee to supply pedestal.
(4 entries).

Class 3. “LA COSTE”

STRETCH DESIGN to be staged in front of a backboard 36” x24” x 4” Backboard to be supplied by committee. Underlay permitted.(4 entries).

SECTION B – “TABLE SCAPES”

Eligible for **TABLE ARTISTRY AWARD**. Fresh, and /or dried plant material and other components permitted.

Class 4. “MARTHA STEWART”

Eligible for the **Concetta De Lillo Award**. Open to Great Kills Garden Club members only.

Semi-formal functional table for 6, to be staged on a rectangular table 72” x 30”. Committee to supply table. (4 entries).

Class 5. “CHRISTOPHER LOWELL”

Table for 2 staged on a bridge table. Committee to supply table .
(4 entries).

Class 6. “SANDRA LEE”

Type II exhibition table staged in front of a backboard . Committee to supply backboard.(4 entries).

SECTION A – “FINISHING TOUCHES” EDUCATIONAL EXHIBITS

Exhibit 2. “FLOWER SCENTS IN PERFUME MAKING”

Staged on a 72” x 30” rectangular table covered in white plastic.

SECTION B – “ARTISTIC CRAFTS”

Eligible for **ARTISTIC CRAFT AWARD**. Fresh and/or dried material permitted.

All exhibits must contain some plant material. Artistic Crafts are competitive and judged by the standard system.

Exhibit 3. **“BAUBLES, BANGLES BEADS”** A necklace made from all natural materials to be placed on a black stand. Black stand provided by committee. (4 entries)

Exhibit 4. “HEADS UP”

A decorated hat to be staged on a Styrofoam head form, supplied by committee. (4 entries)

Exhibit 5. – “PUMP IT UP”

A decorated shoe to be supplied by exhibitor. (4 entries)
