Functional table for two on a bridge table 30" square Table supplied by Committee. (4 entries)

CLASS 6 – “MOONSTRUCK”

All fresco buffet table for six. Staged on a 72" x 30" rectangular table. Table supplied by Committee. (4 entries)

SECTION C - "FANTASIA"

Eligible for **Petite Award**.

CLASS 7 – “PETER PAN”

A petite design (5" max.) using **ALL DRIED** plant material, to be placed on a black shelf 5" h x 11" w x 4" d. Shelf supplied by Committee. (4 entries)

CLASS 8 – “BEAUTY AND THE BEAST”

A small design (8" max.) using a combination of **FRESH & DRIED** plant material to be placed on a black shelf 11" h x 5" w x 4" d. Shelf supplied by Committee. (4 entries)

CLASS 9 – “CINDERELLA”

A small design (8" max.) using **ALL FRESH** plant material to be placed on a black shelf 11" h x 5" w x 4" d. Shelf supplied by Committee. (4 entries)

Eligible for **Arboreal Award.** Single branch, spray or truss 24” or less from tip to cut end.

SECTION B – “THE HOLLY & THE IVY”

BROAD LEAF EVERGREENS/Cut branches

Eligible for **Award of Merit.** Single branch, 24” or less from tip to cut end.

SECTION E – “AMERICAN BEAUTY”

ROSES

Eligible for **Award of Merit.**

Single stem 18” or less from tip to cut end.

SECTION F – “BLACK ORCHID”

CONTAINER GROWN PLANTS – FLOWERING

Eligible for **Grower’s Choice Award.**

An **Underwater** design staged on a black round pedestal 18” in diameter 36” high. Underlay permitted. Pedestal supplied by Committee. (4 entries)

CLASS 3 – “ROAD TO MOROCCO”

Eligible for **Lee Gugliada Award.**

A **Creative** Design staged on a black round pedestal 18" in diameter 36” high. Underlay permitted. Pedestal supplied by Committee. (4 entries)
