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### **DISTRICT AWARDS PROGRAM**

### **PURPOSE**

The District Awards Program provides recognition for the outstanding projects, activities and people of First District. Awards are granted in accordance with the objectives of the Federated Garden Clubs of New York State, Inc. First District encourages clubs or individual members to participate in the District's Awards Program and to document Garden Club activities.

#### **PROCEDURES**

- 1. The Awards year is from January 1st to December 31st of the calendar year.
- 2. **The Deadline to submit an Award Application is October 1st.** Projects, which extend beyond the Awards Deadline, must also be submitted to the Awards Committee by October 1st. The Book of Evidence, if required by the Award, should contain evidence of the project from January to the end of September, with a written description of additional activities planned from October 1st to December 31st of that same year.
- 3. No project may receive more than one District Award.
- 4. Awards are to be presented at the District's Annual and Semi-Annual Meetings as required in April and October of the current year.
- 5. Applications for Awards are sent to the District Awards Chair.
- 6. Applications deemed worthy of consideration at the State level are sent by the District Awards Chair to the State Chairman for consideration.
- 7. To apply for a District Award, use the District Award Application Form. To apply for a State Award, use the FGCNYS, Inc. Award Application Form. See Sample forms in this Manual as well as on sigardenclubs.org website.
- 8. For Award Applications to the National Garden Clubs, Inc. (NGC) or Central Atlantic Region of State Garden Clubs, Inc. (CAR-SGC), see sample Forms in this Manual as well as on sigardenclubs.org website.
- 9. To apply for any Award, a **Letter of Intent** should be sent to the District Awards Chair by **September 1st.** The letter should state the specific awards your Club is applying for. **EXCEPTIONS:** Yearbooks and Publicity Press Books are to be made directly to the **District** Chair by the date set by that Chair. The District Publicity Press Book goes to the State Publicity Press Book Chair.

- 10. For specific instructions on how to prepare a Book of Evidence, see NGC www.gardenclub.org and FGCNYS, Inc.- www.fgcnys.com
- 11. To apply for a Flower Show Schedule Award, send three (3) copies of the Schedule thirty (30) days in advance of the Show to the District Awards Chair with an application form. For a Flower Show, scheduled to be held after October 1st, the Schedule must be submitted by October 1st for evaluation.
- 12. Flower Shows held between October 1st and December 1st, must submit Book of Evidence by December 15th.
- 13. The District Awards Manual will be given to each Club President and Club Award Chairs. The Awards Manual will also be available on sigardenclubs.org website.

### **ACHIEVEMENT AWARDS**

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### 1. UNSOLICITED CITATION TO OTHER THAN A GARDEN CLUB OR GARDEN CLUB MEMBER

May be awarded to an individual or institution other than a Garden Club for a successful activity than exemplifies the purposes of the Federated Garden Clubs of New York State, Inc. and First District. Nominations are by a club member or group of members or First District.

NYS # 12 now 1 NGC now SR-1

### 2. OUTSTANDING CONTRIBUTION OR ACHIEVEMENT CITATION

May be awarded to <u>an</u> individual member of a Garden Club for outstanding contributions or achievements in a field of the Federated Garden Clubs of New York State, Inc and First District endeavors, not necessarily part of a club's activities. Nominations are by District, a club or an individual.

### 3. DIRECTOR'S CITATIONS

Up to three (3) citations may be given at the sole discretion of the Director of First District at the District's Annual and Semi-Annual luncheons.

### 4. COMMENDATION FOR LONG TIME SERVICE AS A MEMBER OF A CLUB

May be awarded to an individual member of a Garden Club with at least 20 years membership who has made significant contributions to the club and Federation. An application letter to First District Awards Chair must state offices held, committees, chaired, etc. Nominations are by a Club President.

### 5. SPECIAL CITATION

May be awarded to an individual and/or club for advancing an objective of the Federation that does not come under any of the other awards.

### CIVIC CONCERN AND IMPROVEMENT AWARDS

### 6. **COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENT CITATION**

May be awarded to a club or a group of clubs for:

- a. A new project
- b. A continuing project

### 7. UNSOLICITED CITATION FOR OTHER THAN A GARDEN CLUB

Unsolicited citations may be awarded to organizations or institutions other than Garden Clubs for completed projects of Civic Improvement upon recommendation of a club, individual or the District with approval of the District Awards Committee. An award may be presented upon recommendation for each club in the District.

### **CONSERVATION AND ENVIRONMENTAL AWARDS**

### 8. THE MARION BRIGGIN BIRD AND/OR CONSERVATION AWARD

May be awarded for a Special Exhibit on Birds or Conservation in a Flower Show. It may be given to the club which scores the highest points in either or both categories. A club that wins the Award may not be considered for the same award the next year but could again compete for the Award after a lapse of 1 year. A \$25 Monetary Award will be given.

### 9. CITATIONS FOR CONSERVATION AND ENVIRONMENTAL PROJECTS

May be awarded to a club for a project or completed phase of a project on the topic of conservation or environmental improvement.

#### 10. CITATION FOR THE BEST CLUB PROGRAM OR STUDY

May be awarded to a club for a club program or study presented by one or more members at a club meeting on the topic of either Conservation or the Environment. Special consideration will be given if the District Program Chair can make the program available to other clubs.

### 11. UNSOLICITED CITATION IN CONSERVATION OR ENVIRONMENT

May be awarded to organizations, institutions or individuals other than Garden Clubs for successful projects or educational programs, which encourage conservation and/or environmental improvement.

NGC now EC 1-6

### **EDUCATIONAL AWARDS**

### 12. EDUCATIONAL EXHIBIT CITATION

May be awarded for an outstanding Educational Exhibit to an individual member or members of a Garden Club. The exhibit must relate to NGC objectives and be designed to instruct. The Application should include:

- 1. A typed summary of the exhibit
- 2. Photographs of the exhibit minimum of 2

The winning exhibit may be displayed at the District Annual Meeting. Categories:

- A. In a Flower Show
- B. Other than a Flower Show

### 13. SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS TO DISTRICT CLUB MEMBERS

First District may offer a Scholarship Award amounting to the registration fee of any course to any one of the following approved FGCNYS schools:

Flower Show

Horticulture

Landscape Design

**Gardening Studies** 

Environmental, etc.

Application should be made in writing to the First District Scholarship Chair. No more than two scholarships may be awarded in a calendar year.

### 14. FLOWER SHOW SCHEDULE CITATION

May be awarded to:

- 1. a club
- 2. a group of clubs

Three (3) copies of the schedule should be submitted to the District Awards Chair, four (4) weeks before the date of the show. One award may be given in each of the following categories:

- b. Holiday Standard Show (NGC # now FS 2)
- c. Patriotic Standard Show (NGC # now FS 3)
- d. Petite Standard Show (NGC # now FS 4)
- e. Club Small Standard Show (NGC # now FS 5)
- f. Holiday Small Standard Show (NGC # now FS 6)
- g. Patriotic Small Standard Show (NGC # now FS 7)
- h. Petite Small Standard Show (NGC # now FS 8)
- i. Standard Home Show (NYS # 23)
- j. Standard Public Buildings Show (NYS # 29)
- k. Historic Show (NYS # 37)

### 15. CITATION FOR A SMALL FLOWER SHOW (FLOWER SHOW IN A BOX/MENTORED SHOW)

A non-competitive citation may be awarded to a club holding a small flower show with or without exhibits.

### 16. CITATION FOR A STANDARD SHOW SCORING 90% TO 94%

May be awarded to a club or a group of clubs for a flower show scoring 90% to 94%. See #14 for categories.

### 17. CITATION FOR STANDARD SHOWS SCORING 95% OR BETTER

May be awarded to a club or a group of clubs for a flower show scoring 95% or better. See Handbook pages 39-52 for Special Exhibits Division requirements. See #14 for categories.

### 18. NEW YORK STATE DESIGN AWARDS

These New York State awards travel to every district in the state. Each district is eligible every 10 years. A photo of the design and a resume type description is required. In the event of a tie, the District Awards Committee will determine the winner.

### A. MAY WALTON FLOWER ARRANGER OF THE YEAR

This award may be given to the garden club member with the highest scoring Tri-Color Design in a Standard Flower Show. First District is eligible in the year 2026.

### B. PAULINE SHERWOOD PETITE AWARD

This award may be given to the garden club member with the highest scoring Petite Design in a Standard Flower Show. First District is eligible in the year 2028.

### 19. SPECIAL EXHIBIT CITATIONS

May be awarded for the best Special Exhibit in a Standard Flower Show in the following categories:

- a. Youth Groups
- b. Sponsored Groups
- c. Artistic Crafts
- d. Gardens

### 20. FIRST DISTRICT ANGELA DOGLIO DESIGN SILVER BOWL

May be awarded to the garden club member who has accumulated the most design points in Standard Flower Shows held within First District's calendar year. The winner of the Silver Bowl is not eligible for the next two years. The Silver Bowl will be presented at the Annual Meeting and Luncheon. Requirements are:

• If there are only two shows, the designer must have entered one show.

### **FLOWER SHOW DISTRICT AWARDS**

### 21. THE LEE GUGLIADA CREATIVE DESIGN AWARD

Presented to the highest rated blue ribbon winner in a Design Division in a specific Section/Class determined by the Flower Show Committee in a Standard Flower Show held within First District's calendar year.

### 22. THE CONCHIE DE LILLO AWARD

Presented to the highest scoring design among the Tri-Color and Designer's Choice award winners in a Standard Flower Show held within First District's calendar year. This Award is sponsored by Judges Council.

### 23. THE ROSE YASOSKY NOVICE AWARD

Presented to the highest rated blue ribbon winner of a Novice competing in a specific Design Division, Section/Class open only to a Novice in a Standard Flower Show held within First District's calendar year. This Award is sponsored by Richmond Ever-Green Garden Club. This is a monetary (\$50.00) award.

#### 24. THE JEANETTE DE LILLO AWARD

Presented to the highest rated blue ribbon winner in the Horticulture Division, Section/Class, Conifers, in a Standard Flower Show held within First District's calendar year. This Award is sponsored by Staten Island Garden Club.

### **GARDEN THERAPY AWARDS**

#### 25. EDNA KUTTRUFF GARDEN THERAPY AWARD

A Silver Bowl may be awarded to:

- a) A Garden Club of First District
- b) An individual member of a Garden club of First District

A short description (no more than two typed pages) of Garden Therapy activities by an individual or club of First District to be submitted to the District Garden Therapy Chair by September 1<sup>st</sup>.

### **HORTICULTURAL AWARDS**

### 26. THE KAREN WOYTOWICH HORTICULTURE SILVER BOWL

The Horticulture Silver Bowl will be awarded to the garden club member who has accumulated the most horticultural points in a Standard Flower Show(s) held within First District's calendar year. The winner of a Silver Bowl for Horticulture is not eligible for the next two years. Requirement as follows:

• If there are only 2 shows, the person must have entered 1 show.

The Silver Bowl will be presented at the District's Annual Meeting and Luncheon.

### 27. THE LILA T. BARBES HORTICULTURE AWARD FOR CONTAINER GROWNED PLANTS

A Citation along with a monetary award (\$50.00) will be awarded to the Garden Club member who has accumulated the most points for Container Grown Plants entered in a Standard Flower Show(s) held in First District's calendar year. This Award is sponsored by Richmond Ever-Green Garden Club. The Winner is not eligible for the next two years. Requirement as follows:

• If there are only 2 shows, the person must have entered 1 show.

This Award will be presented at the District's Annual Meeting and Luncheon.

### 28. CITATION FOR YEAR LONG HORTICULTURAL STUDY

May be awarded for a year long study within a club, culminating in a specific result or gain, such as class or exhibit in a flower show, community project, field trip, etc.

### 29. LILLIAN AREND HORTICULTURIST OF THE YEAR SILVER TRAY

May be awarded to a member selected by the District Awards Committee. This will be a traveling award to be presented to a different District each year beginning in the awards year of 2020 with District 10. First District is eligible in 2029. The deadline for submission of an entry is January 1.

- Horticulture exhibit must have been entered in a Standard Flower Show
- Horticulture exhibit must have won the Award of Horticultural Excellence
- Entry must include a photo of the exhibit with proper naming as required by a Flower Show Schedule
- Entry must be point scored

### **Horticulture/Design Points**

Points for District Horticulture and Design Awards are:

First award = 5 points (only one first award for each class)

Second award = 4 points

Third award = 3 points

Honorable Mention = 2 points

### **LANDSCAPE AND HISTORIC PRESERVATION CITATIONS**

### 30. LANDSCAPE DESIGN CITATION

May be awarded to a member club or a group of clubs that has made the most significant contribution in providing planning and planting of a landscape project. Projects might include landscaping of churches, synagogues, memorial gardens, home grounds, school grounds, parks, libraries, hospitals, etc.

### 31. HISTORIC PRESERVATION CITATION

May be awarded to a member, club or a group of clubs for the completion of a historic preservation project, such as the restoration of a park, building and/or garden of importance to the heritage of a particular locality. Photographs before and after the restoration should be included.

### 32. CITATION FOR PROMOTION OF IMPROVED LANDSCAPE DESIGN IN THE COMMUNITY

May be awarded to a member, club or group of clubs for working with community officials on beautification awards programs, plant clinics, community gardening and participating in other community projects dealing with promotion of improved landscape design in the community.

### **MEMBERSHIP AWARDS**

### 33. FIRST DISTRICT MEMBERSHIP SILVER BOWL

May be awarded to a club for the largest increase in a club's membership during the award year. The award will be based on District dues paid.

### 34. RECRUITER OF THE YEAR MEMBERSHIP AWARD

May be awarded to the Garden Club member who brings in the greatest number of new members to their club. The District Membership Chair must document new memberships.

### 35. INDIVIDUAL MEMBER COMMENDATION

A certificate may be obtained from National Headquarters to honor a club member for long-time membership, dedication and outstanding contributions to the club. Refer to National Council's Member Services Catalog for details.

### 36. LUNCHEON PARTICIPATION CLUB AWARD

May be awarded to the club who has the largest ratio of luncheon attendees to club members.

### **PUBLICATION AWARDS**

### 37. AWARDS FOR CLUB PUBLICATIONS

May be awarded in each of the following categories:

- a. Informational leaflets, booklets, etc. for club members
- b. Information material to other than garden clubs that promote Federation objectives
- c. Cookbooks, or other fundraising publications
- d. Other writings by individuals in non- garden club publications on subjects concerning garden club interests.
