

DIVISION II - DESIGN (cont.)

SECTION B – “BRINGING IN THE HARVEST”

Eligible for **Table Artistry Award**.

Exhibitor has choice of fresh, dried, or dried treated plant material. Underlay permitted. (HB pg. 76-77)

CLASS 4 – “MARIACHI SERENADE”

Alfresco Dining for Two on a free standing bridge table 30” square. Table supplied by Committee. (4 entries)

CLASS 5 – “CRÈME DE LA CREME”

Brunch for One staged on a free standing snack table 17” x 14 3/4”. Table supplied by Committee. (4 entries)

CLASS 6 – “PERFECTO”

Buffet table for Six staged on a free standing 72” L x 30”W x 30”H table. Table supplied by Committee. (4 entries)

SECTION C - "ROOT OF LIFE"

Eligible for **Petite Award**. All designs will be placed on a black wooden niche on the piano against an ivory wall. Each class has a different requirement. (HB pg. 73)

CLASS 7 – “HEART OF FIRE”

A petite design not to exceed 5” max. using **ALL DRIED** plant material, to be placed on a black shelf 8”h x 5”w x 4”d. Shelf supplied by Committee. (4 entries)

CLASS 8 – “IT’S ALIVE”

A small design not to exceed 8” max. using **All FRESH** plant material to be placed on a black shelf 11”h x 5”w x 4”d. Shelf supplied by Committee. (4 entries)

CLASS 9 – “BUTTERFLY WINGS”

A petite design not to exceed 5” max. using a combination **FRESH & DRIED** plant material to be placed on a black shelf 8”h x 5”w x 4”d. Shelf supplied by Committee. (4 entries)

DIVISION III - BOTANICAL ARTS

“BOUNTIFUL BEAUTY”

Eligible for **Botanical Arts Artistic Crafts Award**. Exhibitor has choice of fresh, dried, or dried treated plant material. (HB pg. 94-95). Chair/Entries: Stella Gasparo 718-983-7386

SECTION A - “HOW SWEET IT IS”

CLASS 1 - "SALUTE"

A clear wine glass using **ALL FRESH** plant material to be staged on a glass block 8” x 8”H x 4”D. Wine glass & glass block supplied by Committee. (4 entries)

CLASS 2. “VICTORIA’S SECRET”

A hat using **FRESH & DRIED** plant material to be staged on a styrofoam mannequin head on a free standing table 72”L x 30”W x 30”H. Hat & mannequin head supplied by Committee. (4 entries).

CLASS 3. “THE ‘RING’”

A napkin ring to be staged on a 10” black felt covered cake plate and stand using **ALL DRIED** plant materials. Napkin ring & cake plate supplied by Committee. Exhibitor to supply napkin. (4 entries)

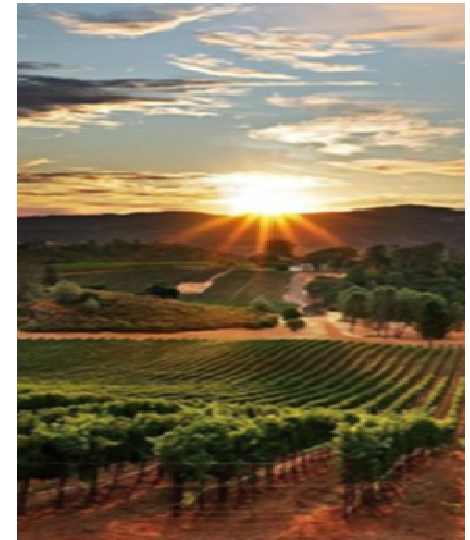

DIVISION I – HORTICULTURE **“SACRAMENTO ”**

Eligible for **Award of Horticultural Excellence.**

SECTION A – “MOSCATO” **FLOWERING BRANCHES/CUT BRANCHES**

Eligible for **Arboreal Award.** Each specimen must be less than 30” in length from cut end to apical tip, & include several nodes & blooms with the central leader. Staged in glass containers supplied by Exhibitors.

- CLASS** 1. *Azalea*
2. *Philadelphus virginialis* (Mock Orange)
3. *Rhododendron*
4. Any other worthy named specimens.

SECTION B – “WOODY” **BROAD LEAF EVERGREENS/CUT BRANCHES**

Eligible for **Arboreal Award.** Single branch broad leaf evergreen including several nodes & an apical tip with the central leader 30” or less from tip to cut end. Staged in glass containers supplied by Exhibitors.

- CLASS** 5. *Aucuba*
5a. *Variiegated Aucuba*
6. *Euonymus*
6a. *Variiegated Euonymus*
7. *Ilex* (Holly)
7a. *Variiegated Ilex* (Holly)
8. Any other worthy named specimens.

SECTION C – “EARTHY” **CUT BRANCHES/CONIFERS**

Eligible for **Arboreal Award & Jeanette De Lillo Award.** Single branch conifer must be less than 30” in length from cut end to apical tip and include several nodes & the central leader. Staged in glass containers provided by Exhibitors.

- CLASS** 9. *Chamaecyparis* (Cypress)
10. *Juniperus* (Juniper)
11. *Picea* (Spruce)
12. *Pinus* (Pine)
13. *Taxus* (Yew)
14. *Thuja* (Arborvitae)
15. Any Dwarf Conifer
16. Any other worthy named specimens.

SECTION D – “ROBUST” **PERENNIALS**

Eligible for **Award of Merit.**
No more than 24” from tip to cut end Staged in glass containers provided by Exhibitors.

- CLASS** 17. *Aster*
18. *Chrysanthemum*
19. *Sedum*
20. Any other worthy named specimens.

SECTION E – “AMERICAN GROWTH” **FRUITS & VEGETABLES** (HB pg. 59)

Eligible for **Award of Merit.** Specimen to be placed on a 10” white paper plate supplied by Committee.

- CLASS** 21. *Gourds*
22. *Peppers* (3 specimens)
23. *Tomatoes* (3 specimens)
24. Any other worthy named specimens.

SECTION F – “BOLD” **CONTAINER GROWN PLANTS – FLOWERING**

Eligible for **Grower’s Choice Award.**
Container 10” or less in diameter. Flowering, single or self multiplying plant, same genus, cultivar & color. Double potted permitted.

- CLASS** 25. *Begonia*
26. *Gesneriad* (including Saintpaulia)
27. *Orchid*
28. Any other worthy named specimens.

SECTION G – “CRISP” **CONTAINER GROWN PLANTS – FOLIAGE**

Eligible for **Grower’s Choice Award.**
Container 10” or less in diameter. Single or self multiplying plant, same genus, cultivar & color. Double potted permitted.

- CLASS** 29. *Herbs*
30. *Philodendron*
31. *Sansevieria*
32. Any other worthy named specimens.

SECTION H - “CORKED” **CONTAINER GROWN PLANTS -** **SUCCULENTS/CACTI**

Eligible for **Grower’s Choice Award.**
Container 10” or less in diameter. Single or self multiplying plant, same genus, cultivar & color. Double potted permitted.

SECTION A – “TAKE TIME TO SMELL THE ROSES”

Eligible for **Designer’s Choice Award**

Exhibitor has complete freedom to choose plant materials and other components within NGC, Inc. policies. All pedestals are against a wall.

CLASS 1. “LIGHT OF LOVE”

An **Illuminary** design, (HB pg. 74) staged on a black round pedestal 18” in diameter, 36” high against an ivory wall. Underlay permitted, **Battery operated lights** must be used & supplied by Exhibitor. Pedestal supplied by Committee. (4 entries)

CLASS 2. “LET IT FLOW”

An **Underwater** design, (HB pg.79) staged on a white 18” square pedestal, 36” high against an ivory wall. Underlay permitted. Pedestal supplied by Committee. (4 entries)

CLASS 3. “HEARD IT THROUGH THE GRAPEVINE”

Eligible for **Lee Gugliada Award**

A **Multi-Rhythmic** design, (HB pg. 75) staged against a free standing backboard on the Stage. Underlay permitted. Backboard supplied by Committee. (4 entries)
