SECTION B – “SHOWERS OF HAPPINESS”

Eligible for **Table Artistry Award & Sue Fink Award**. Exhibitor has choice of fresh, dried, or dried treated plant material. Underlay permitted. (HB pg. 76-77)

CLASS 4 – “MORNING GLORY”

Breakfast for one staged on a free standing snack table 17” x 14 3/4”. Table supplied by Committee. (4 entries)

CLASS 5 – “I ONLY HAVE EYES FOR YOU”

Functional table for two on a free standing bridge table 30" square. Table supplied by Committee. (4 entries)

CLASS 6 – “PERFECT SETTINGS”

Semi-formal table for four. Staged on a free standing 48” round table. Table supplied by Committee. (4 entries)

SECTION C - "A LITTLE BIT OF LOVE"

Eligible for **Petite Award**. Staged on a 72”Lx30”Hx30”D table covered in a pink tablecloth against an ivory wall. (HB pg. 73)

CLASS 7 – “FIRST KISS”

A small design (8” max.) using a combination of **FRESH & DRIED** plant material, to be placed on a glass block 8”L x 8”H x 4”D. Glass block supplied by Committee. (4 entries)

CLASS 8 – “FLOWER GIRL”

A small design (8” max.) using **All FRESH** plant material to be placed on a glass block 8”L x 8”H x 4”D. Glass block supplied by Committee. (4 entries)

CLASS 9 – “THE RING”

A petite design (5” max.) using **ALL DRIED** plant material to be placed on a glass block 8”L x 8”H x 4”D. Glass block supplied by Committee. (4 entries)

DIVISION III - BOTANICAL ARTS "TRADITIONS"

Eligible for **Botanical Arts Artistic Crafts Award**. Exhibitor has choice of fresh, dried, or dried treated plant material. (HB pg. 94-95)

SECTION A - “GETTING READY”

CLASS 1 - "VEILED BEAUTY"

A bridal headpiece using **FRESH & DRIED** flowers to be placed on a Styrofoam mannequin head, supplied by Committee. (4 entries)

CLASS 2. “THE GROOM”

A boutonniere not more than 4”W x 6”H made of **FRESH** flowers to be placed on an individual 11” x 14” black foam board on a black easel. Board & Easel supplied by Committee. (4 entries).

CLASS 3. “MASTERPIECE”

A cake topper to be placed on a 10” white doily on a black felt covered cake plate & stand using all **DRIED** flowers. Cake plate & stand supplied by the Committee. (4 entries)

BOTANICAL ARTS - PHOTOGRAPHY “TRADITIONS”

CLASS 5. “TRADITIONAL WHITE”

An image that includes some white plant material (i.e. white flower, etc.) (Limited to 12 entries)

CLASS 6. “SUNNY DAY”

An image taken in sunlight that includes plant material. (Limited to 12 entries)

SECTION A – “BUDS IN BLOOM”

FLOWERING BRANCHES/CUT BRANCHES

Eligible for **Arboreal Award.** Each specimen must be less than 30” in length from cut end to apical tip, & include several nodes & blooms with the central leader. Staged in glass containers supplied by Exhibitors.

- CLASS**
1. Rhododendron
 2. Philadelphus virginialis (Mock Orange)
 3. Azalea
 4. Any other worthy named specimens.

SECTION B – “EMERALDS”

BROAD LEAF EVERGREENS/CUT BRANCHES

Eligible for **Award of Merit.** Single branch broad leaf ever-green including several nodes & an apical tip with the central leader 30” or less from tip to cut end. Staged in glass containers supplied by Exhibitors.

CUT BRANCHES/CONIFERS

Eligible for **Arboreal Award & Jeanette De Lillo Award.**

Single branch conifer must be less than 30” in length from cut end to apical tip and include several nodes & the central leader. Staged in glass containers provided by Exhibitors.

No more than 24” from tip to cut end. Staged in glass containers provided by Exhibitors.

SECTION E – “GARDEN OF LOVE”

ROSES

Eligible for **Award of Merit.**

No more than 30” from tip to cut end. Staged in glass containers provided by Exhibitors.

 24. Any other worthy named specimens.

SECTION F – “ROMANCE”

CONTAINER GROWN PLANTS – FLOWERING

Eligible for **Grower’s Choice Award.**

Container 10” or less in diameter. Flowering, single or self multiplying plant, same genus, cultivar & color. Double potted permitted.

SECTION G – “POTTED PLEASURES”

CONTAINER GROWN PLANTS – FOLIAGE

Eligible for **Grower’s Choice Award.**

Container 10” or less in diameter. Single or self multiplying plant, same genus, cultivar & color. Double potted permitted.

SECTION H – “STUCK WITH YOU”

CONTAINER GROWN PLANTS - CACTUS/SUCCULENTS

Container 10” or less in diameter. Single or self multiplying plant, same genus, cultivar & color. Double potted permitted.

SECTION A – “HERE COMES THE BRIDE”

Eligible for **Designer’s Choice Award**

Exhibitor has complete freedom to choose plant materials and other components within NGC, Inc. policies. All pedestals are free standing.

CLASS 1. “SATIN AND LACE”

An **Illuminary** design, (HB pg. 74) staged on a free standing black round pedestal 18” in diameter, 36” high against an ivory wall. Underlay permitted, Battery Operated Lights must be used & supplied by Exhibitor. Pedestal supplied by Committee. (4 entries)

CLASS 2. “ SOMETHING OLD, SOMETHING NEW”

Eligible for **Lee Gugliada Award**

A **Cascade** design, (HB pg.73) staged on a free standing white 18” square pedestal, 36” high against an ivory wall. Underlay permitted. Pedestal supplied by Committee. (4 entries)

CLASS 3. “SOMETHING BORROWED, SOMETHING BLUE”

A **Spatial Thrust** design, (HB pg. 75) staged on a free standing black round pedestal 18” in diameter, 36” high against an ivory wall. Underlay permitted. Pedestal supplied by Committee. (4 entries)
